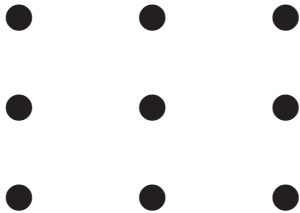


Test Yourself

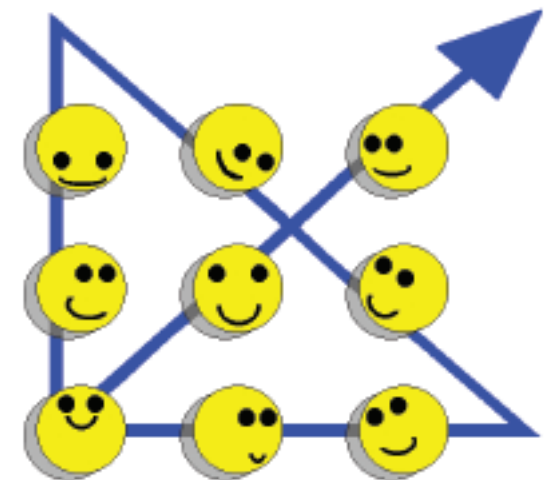
